

# Overview of Scholarship Programs

## YOUNG SCHOLARS PROGRAM



The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Young Scholars Program offers the most personalized, generous scholarship and educational support in the nation to exceptionally promising students from families who have financial need. Young Scholars receive comprehensive educational advising and financial support from the 8th grade through high school to pursue their unique academic and talent goals. Applications are accepted from January to March. Up to 65 Young Scholars are selected for this program each year. Final notification is in early fall.

## COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend the nation's best 4-year colleges and universities. College Scholars receive up to \$40,000 per year, college planning support, ongoing advising, and the opportunity to network with the larger JKCF Scholar community. Applications are accepted from September to November. Up to 40 College Scholars are selected for this program each year. Final notification is in late March.

## UNDERGRADUATE TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP



The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship is a highly selective scholarship for the nation's top community college students seeking to complete their bachelor's degrees at 4-year colleges or universities. The Foundation provides up to \$40,000 per year, making it the largest private scholarship for community college transfer students in the country. Applications are accepted from October to December. Up to 85 Undergraduate Transfer Scholars are selected each year. Final notification is in April.
