Welcome New Scholars Video Submission Filming Tips

Instructions:

- Aim to keep your video to no more than 90 seconds long.
- Send your video (MP4 or MOV format preferred) to studio@jkcf.org via WeTransfer. If you can't get WeTransfer to work, send us an email so we can make an alternative arrangement for you on Box, Dropbox, or Google Drive. A reminder that, by submitting your video to us, you consent to our usage and editing of the content.

5 Helpful Tips for Creating Your Video:

- 1. If inside, use a well-lit interior room with a simple neutral color wall behind you. Do not sit in front of any windows or bright backgrounds as that will negatively affect the picture quality.
- 2. Avoid sitting close to noise-generating sources (like AC units, fans, running water and wind if outside).
- 3. Keep doors and windows closed to reduce external background noise.
- 4. Stay approximately 3 feet away from your device as this will ensure the best audio quality.
- After hitting the record button, allow a few seconds before you start speaking; when you are finished speaking, also allow a few seconds to pass before clicking the stop button. This provides some buffer time for our editing process.

Device & Software Tips:

• Recording with QuickTime:

- Open QuickTime Player.
- o Go to File and choose "New Movie recording." A video screen will pop up.
- Hit the red button to record the video (see tips above).
- When finished, hit the same button to finish recording (see tips above).
- o Save the file. When prompted enter your name and save it to your desktop.

Recording with a mobile device:

- o If you don't have a tripod, ask a friend for help <u>or</u> prop your device up on a stable platform (like a table, desk, bookcase, etc.) in <u>landscape orientation</u> (i.e. sideways).
- Open your camera app and select video.
- o Click record (see tips above).
- When finished, end the recording (see tips above)
