# Eligibility

---

- Graduating from a U.S. high school in spring 2024
- Enrolling in a four -year college in fall 2024
- Cumulative, unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above
- Maximum family adjusted gross income of \$95,000 annually



## Application Components

---

- Demographic and household info
- High school transcript
- Extracurricular activities/résumé
- Two recommendations
- Written response questions, including college plans
- Family financial information

# Selection Criteria

---

## Academic Achievement

Classes and grades, recommendations,  
enthusiasm for learning, higher level thinking  
and analysis

## Leadership

Initiative, community involvement, service to  
others

## Persistence

Goal-setting, response to challenges
